



UCI Biosafety Cabinet Certification, Maintenance & Repair



Biosafety cabinets are primary barrier protection for individuals working with biologic materials. This equipment must be properly maintained and certified every year.

- All biosafety cabinets must be certified annually.
- New biosafety cabinets must be validated by certification before they are put into service.
- All biosafety cabinets must be certified after they have been repaired or relocated.

In order to maintain consistent safety standards in UCI laboratories, EH&S and Purchasing have negotiated a [UC-wide contract](#) for the biosafety cabinet (BSC) certification and maintenance. Each laboratory is responsible for certification and maintenance of BSC
