

Biosafety Cabinet Certification, Maintenance & Repair



Biosafety cabinets (BSCs) are the primary barrier protection for individuals working with biohazardous materials. BSCs must be properly maintained and:

- All biosafety cabinets must be certified annually.
- New biosafety cabinets must be certified before they are first used.
- All biosafety cabinets must be certified after any repair or relocation.
- Each laboratory is responsible for certification and maintenance of BSCs they use.

EH&S and Purchasing have negotiated a UC-wide contract for the certification and maintenance of biosafety cabinets to Technical Safety Services, Inc.
