

Temporary Food Permit: Booth Setup Requirement Summary

PLEASE NOTE: ALL TEMPORARY FOOD FACILITIES SHALL HAVE SOME FORM OF OVERHEAD PROTECTION. FOR EXAMPLE, A SOLID ROOF CONSTRUCTION OR A CANOPY. NO FOOD PREPARATION OR COOKING IS ALLOWED AT HOME.

Prepackaged Food

What is prepackaged food?

Prepackaged food is food in its original, unopened container from the manufacturer or approved food facility.



Items prepackaged in individual servings require:

- Food Booth: Overhead protection
- Handwashing: not required
- No open food onsite.



Prepackaged food with onsite portioning

Items prepackaged with food that needs to be portioned onsite (open food) require:

- Food Booth: Overhead protection
- Handwashing: 2.5-gallon water container with a spigot to allow hands free washing, a catch bucket for wastewater, paper towels, and liquid soap in a pump dispenser
- Extra backup set of serving utensils
