

What should you do if someone is...

It's everyone's job to support the health and wellbeing of the Anteater community, and while most people are doing a great job, there are times we can all use a reminder.

Not Wearing a Face Covering



Ask if the individual is aware that face coverings are required.



If available, offer to give the individual a face covering. To get a face covering, visit m.uci.edu/face-cover. Offer to show the individual the posted signage (generally posted at the entrance to the building or department).



If non-compliance continues, you may ask the person to leave or you may simply leave and inform a leader in the area.

Not Following COVID-19 Signage

(All persons must wear a face covering indoors, regardless of vaccination status, etc.)



Ask if the individual is aware of the posted signage.



Offer to show the individual the posted signage (signage accessible for people with visual disabilities is located outside of the front doors of most buildings).



If non-compliance continues, you may ask the person to leave or you may simply leave and inform a leader in the area.
