Safety Lab Practices:

Many standard lab practices double as effective infection control measures:

- Staff should continue to wear the same PPE they use in normal conditions.
- Routine handwashing, especially performed after doffing gloves, assists in potentially preventing contamination from experiments onto clean surfaces. Handwashing also works well in limiting the spread of common illnesses.
- Maintain standard disinfection protocols and consider expanding them to surfaces in labs where staff frequently work.
