Workplace Violence

The threat or use of physical force against an employee that results in, or has a high likelihood of resulting in, injury, psychological trauma, or stress, regardless of whether the employee sustains an injury.

Behaviors of Concern

Observable, identifiable behaviors that an individual may exhibit if they are on the pathway to violence.

- Substance abuse
- Suicidal Ideation / Lack of future orientation
- Concerning communications / Violent ideation
- Withdrawal or becoming more isolated
- Significant change in appearance
- Significant change in behavior
- Significant change in personality
- Lashing out defensively
- Obsession with one topic (grievance/belief)

Prohibited Behaviors

Behaviors that are a policy or law violation.

- Destruction of property
- Stalking
- Illegal weapons possession/use
- Physical Violence
- Verbal/Written/Implied Threats
- Disruptive behavior
- Harassing behavior
- Hate or Bias related behavior
- Criminal behavior
